Mr. Khoja has served in sr management positions in national and multi-national telecommunications companies for over 15 years. He has extensive experience in nurturing start-up businesses from infancy through development, and as president and CEO has led several GSM start-up companies into major market players. He is currently the chairman and CEO of EXI Wireless Inc. and management board member of COO Croatian Telecommunication.

Mr. Khoja has also directed marketing and sales strategy for companies such as ERA GSM (Poland), Spectonics Microsystems, and RAM Mobile Data. His involvement in the telecommunications sector in Afghanistan began as a volunteer consultant to AKFED in an initiative to install the nationwide private communications infrastructure. In 2003, Mr. Khoja was appointed as the CEO for the Telecom Development Company Afghanistan Ltd. In one year under his leadership, Roshan has grown to be Afghanistan's largest mobile provider.

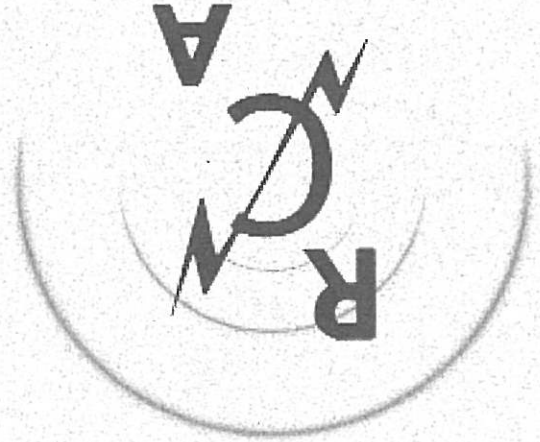
