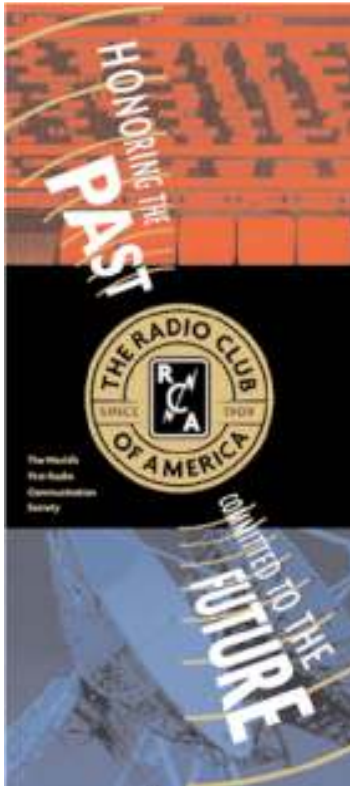

Technical Symposium

This year's RCA Technical Symposium starts at 2:00 PM, and is loaded with presentations. "Wireless Telecommunications Requirements of Critical Infrastructure Providers" is the tentative title of a presentation set to be presented jointly by **Mark Madden** (Global Practice Leader, Alcatel-Lucent Business Communication Strategy Consulting) and **Kelly McNair** (manager of the Engineering and Operations/Telecom group of Oncor Electric Delivery).
