To aid in the Nomination process, here are some suggestions for Awards Nominators from the RCA Nominating Committee:

As the Nominator it is best to nominate someone that you are familiar with. The person nominated should have made an important contribution to the field of interest covered by the Award.

To assist in making sure the nominee has been nominated in the correct Award Category one should first consult the list of previous recipients. Then ensure that the contributions of these recipients are understood. Before completing the nomination form the nominator should make sure that the contributions of the nominee satisfies the description of the award.

The Awards Committee is not allowed to make changes to the form received. The nominator should also provide details that are meaningful in detailing the nominees contributions, as some of the Award Committee Members may not be familiar with the candidate outside of what is received and then read on the form. Nominators must be specific in describing the impact of the contribution of the individual.

Providing a letter of support of the nominee's nomination by another individual included in the nomination with their perspective may further the nominee's chances for selection.

It is a rewarding experience when your nominee receives an award, and following these guidelines will help improve the chances for success in your nomination!
